In the March Newsletter I talked about our Identity in Christ. Now since we know WHO we are in Christ, we need to understand our AUTHORITY in Christ.

Why?

Because understanding our authority in Christ is KEY to dealing with diversity in this world.

***“for everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. Who is it that overcomes the world? Only the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God.” (1 John 5:4–5, NIV)***

What is faith?

***“Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.” (Hebrews 11:1, NIV)***

It’s not what you feel, experience, or see. It is believing God and what He says about something even though things may seem different. That’s Faith.

The Bible is full of God’s promises.

*(Example: God can give us a peace that passes all understanding.)*

Do we believe that? Do we trust Him? That’s Faith.

When He says that He has given us authority over the evil one, are we going to believe Him and claim that authority? That’s Faith.

***“Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;” (Proverbs 3:5, NIV)***

So how do we get faith? Hearing the Word of God

***“Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ.” (Romans 10:17, NIV)***
